This notice is about how we use the information you provide us in the Achieve Parent Survey, and how we will keep it safe.

About us

Achieve is the personal development and wellbeing programme which your child/ ward is engaged in. It is part of The Woodsmith Education Programme and is funded and managed by Anglo American and the Woodsmith Foundation; and developed in conjunction with your child/ward's school.

About information we already hold

Your child has already registered for the programme, and we have collected some information about them from our registration form, with your consent. You can see the privacy statement under which that information was collected by scanning this QR code:

About the information we will collect in this survey

We are interested to know your thoughts and feelings about the Achieve programme and your child's participation in it. This is so that we can assess the effectiveness of the programme. Our intention is that we will ask you similar questions again in a year or so to see if your feelings have changed. We will collect: your name, your child's name and school, and your opinions about the scheme.

Who will see the information and what information will be collected by them?

We need to share the information with some trusted partners for monitoring, evaluation, and statistical purposes. We will not release the data to anyone who is not authorised to receive it, nor for any commercial use. Any data shared for research, monitoring and evaluation purposes will be anonymised.

The information managed by us and our partners

Your personal information will be shared with our partner organisation used to deliver the programme, including: Anglo American; NYBEP Ltd; North Yorkshire Youth (NYY) and (only for schools in the relevant district), Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council.

About how will we keep your information safe

We are committed to protecting the security of the personal information which we collect about you. In support of this commitment, we have implemented a range of technical, physical, and organisational controls to ensure an appropriate level of security in place over your data. For example, we make sure that our delivery partners have adequate security in place to protect your data and we put contracts in place with our partners to ensure that the data is used appropriately and where it is transferred outside the UK that it will be looked after.

About how long will we keep your information

We will store the data for no longer than 8 years. We keep the data this long in order to ascertain if the programme has had an impact on progression through education and into employment.
