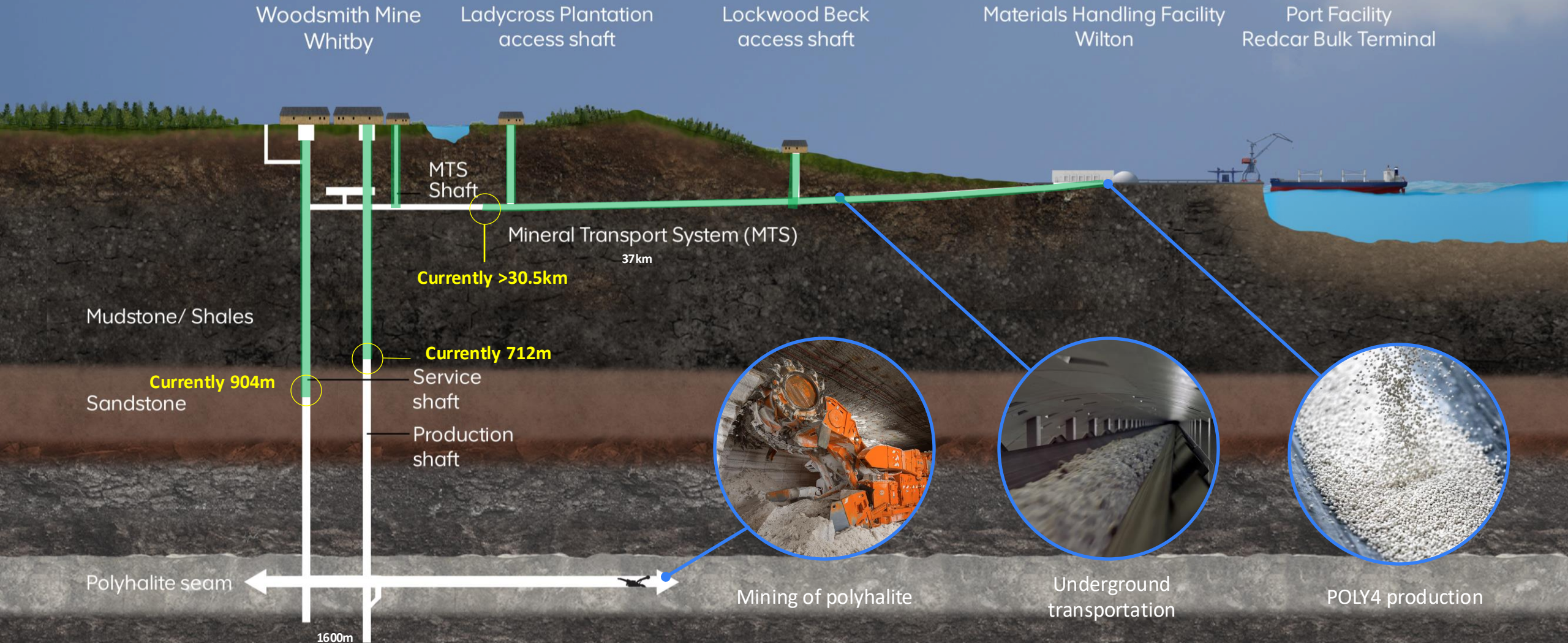

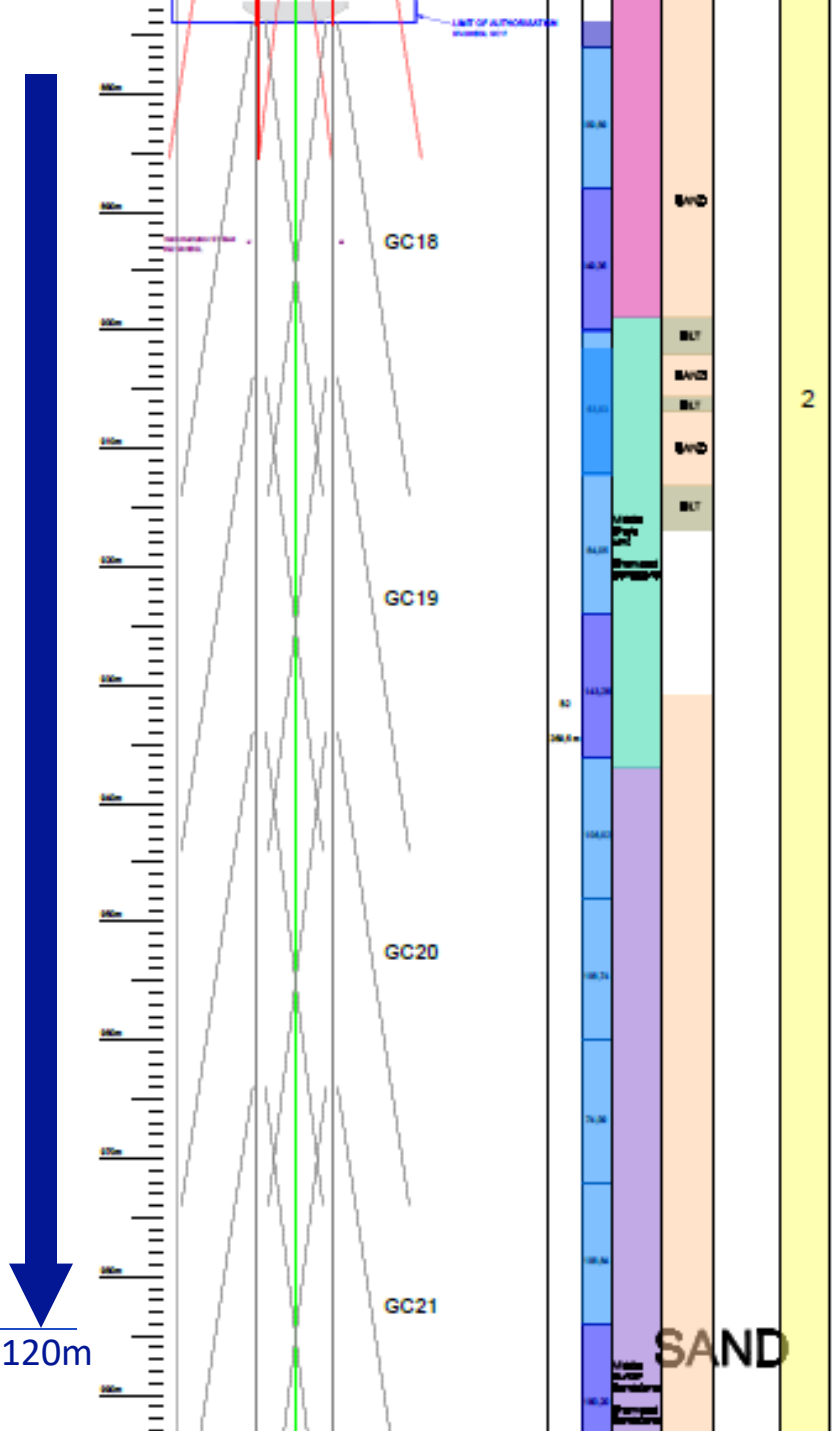
Woodsmith Project overview

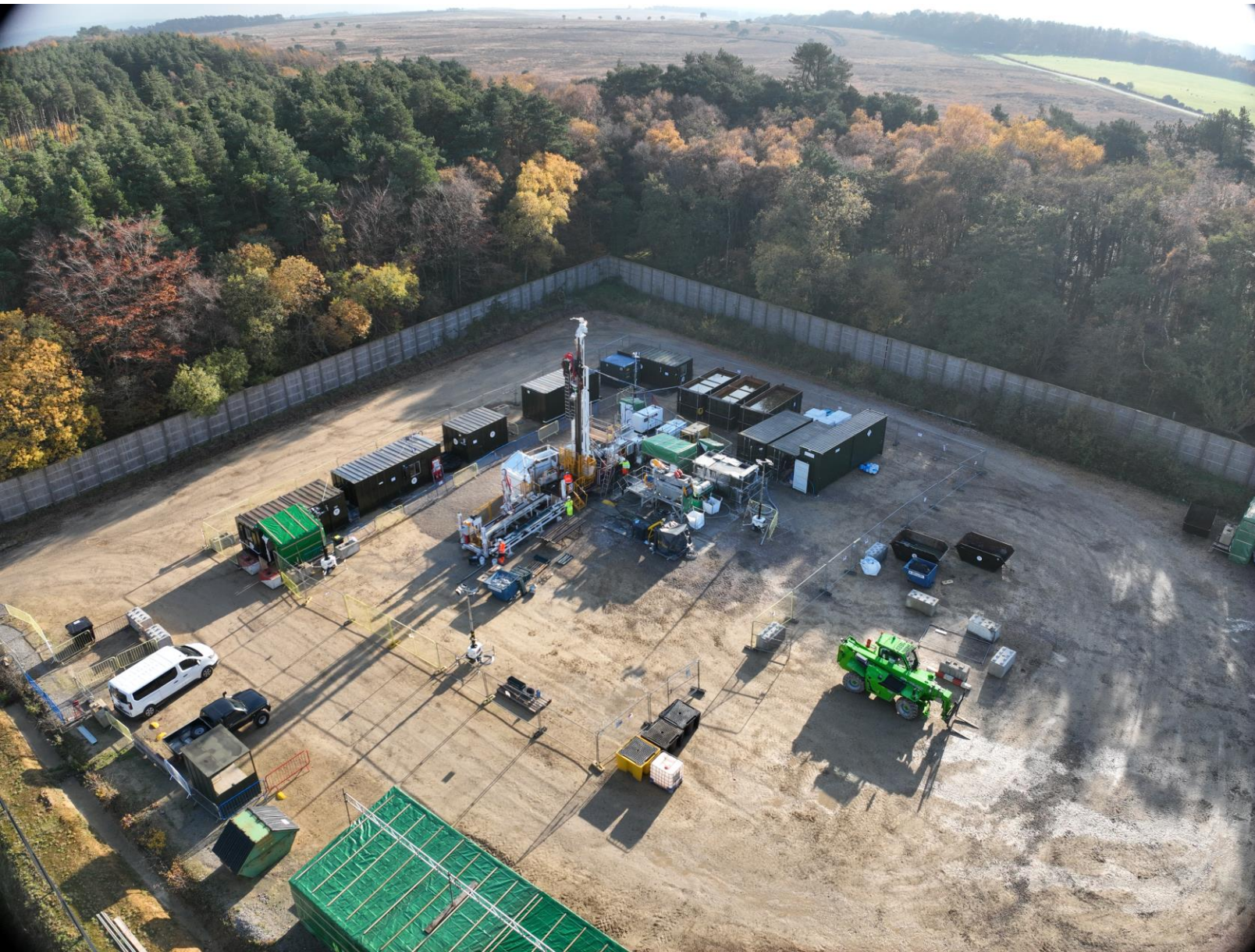








Exploratory boreholes

- Enables development of a well defined Woodsmith Mine Plan
- Supports future investment in the project
- Drilling for 6-9 months + site set-up and restoration
- Commitment to minimising impact:
 - Rig < 15m tall
 - Noise
 - Light
 - Traffic
 - Groundwater
- Ongoing community engagement

Social Impact

Construction to date

- 1,000 people working on the Woodsmith Project (peak >2,200)
- 76% local workforce
- 2,800 indirect jobs
- £452m regional supply chain expenditure since 2022
- £1.94 billion added to the regional economy of Yorkshire and the North-East since construction started
- Since 2021 our Thriving Communities Programme has:
 - o Engaged 37,000 students
 - o Created 183 new businesses
 - o Supported 1,547 people to build their skills
 - o Supported 1,900 local business
- Woodsmith Foundation supported 765 projects in since 2017

Operations*

- 1,150 long-term high-skilled jobs
- >3,000 indirect jobs
- £12m annual contribution to the Woodsmith Foundation

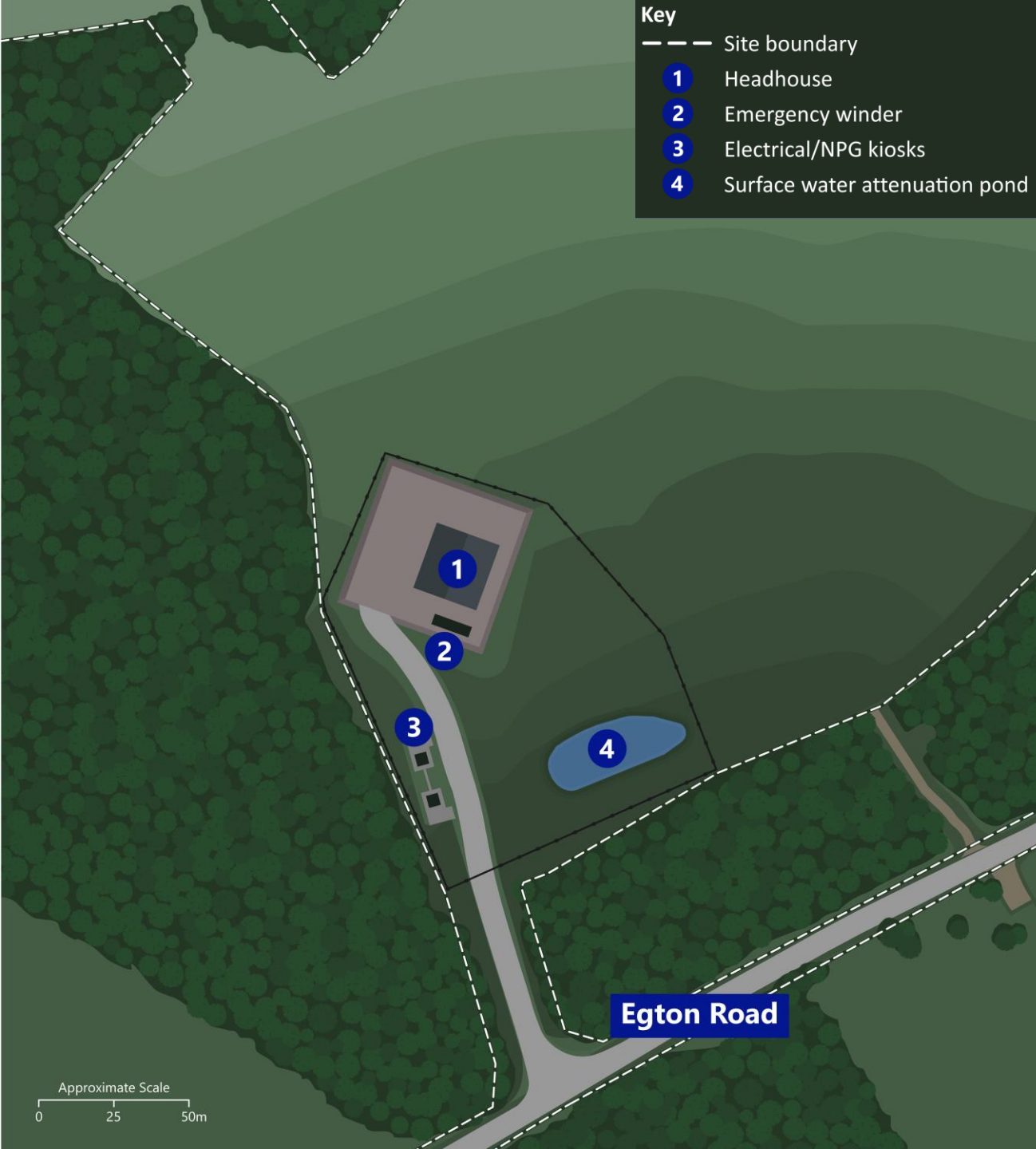
Ladycross Plantation

When the project is operational the shaft will be covered with a small agricultural style building.

An emergency rescue winder, electrical infrastructure and a surface water pond will be the only other permanent development.

The locations of the shaft and access road have moved from their original locations in our existing permission.

Remove the need to permanently store excavated material from the tunnel.

The agricultural style building over the shaft will incorporate a small office, and emergency exhaust fans.

Amendments include:

- Fire water tanks & pump station
- Wastewater storage tanks
- Electrical substation

Sensitively designed to suit the site's agricultural setting and partially screened.

Remove the need to permanently store excavated material from the tunnel.
