



- · Low job and business density
- Low paid, low skilled, part-time jobs
- Ageing population, outward migration of young people
- Low levels of investment, R&D and FDI
- Pockets of significant deprivation
- · Low levels of skills and attainment
- Outcome gap for disadvantaged students
- Poor health
